



## Guelph Chamber hosts Deputy Governor of the Bank of Canada

**February 29, 2016**— On Wednesday, February 24, the Guelph Chamber of Commerce hosted Lawrence Schembri, Deputy Governor of the Bank of Canada, at the latest iteration of the Chamber's Guelph Economic Leadership Forum. Hosted in partnership with RBC, this Forum – held at Cutten Fields – provided an avenue for community and business leaders to discuss with the Deputy Governor General risks to financial stability and how the private sector and individuals might be impacted.

This was the first time that Guelph has hosted a member of the Governing Council of the Bank of Canada, and proved to be an extremely timely event – especially considering the recent national editorial labeling Guelph Canada's 'jobs powerhouse.' Guelph has the lowest unemployment in the country and is the fifth fastest growing jurisdiction in Canada with one of the highest GDPs per capita in the country.
